

Fire Prevention Safety

Reduce wildfire risk to your home by doing the following in summer:

- ✓ **FIREWORKS** are illegal in the County of San Diego
- ✓ Clear the view of your house number so it can be easily seen from the street
- ✓ Trim all branches overhanging house, clean roof/gutters of leaves and needles
- ✓ Create a fuel free zone 0-5 feet from all structures with no combustible materials
- ✓ Clear dead wood and dense flammable vegetation near your home
- ✓ Remove all dead and dying vegetation including weeds, tree limbs, and branches from property
- ✓ Do all maintenance before 10 a.m. or after 6 p.m.
 - **NEVER** in the heat of the day or when the wind is blowing!
 - **NEVER** burn weeds, trash, or rubbish.
 - **NEVER** use lawn mowers to mow dry vegetation.
 - **NEVER** put yourself in harms way to extinguish a fire!
 - Keep a cell phone nearby and call 911 immediately in case of a fire.
